

## Free NaturalReader 9.0 Basic Instructions

NaturalReader is a basic text-to-speech tool.

### How to Locate and Start-up NaturalReader on your Computer

1. Go to your desktop
2. Find and double click on the **Free NaturalReader 2009** icon
3. Or go to **Start, Programs** and find **NaturalSoft, Free** on your menu bar and then **Free NaturalReader 2009**

### How to Open your E-text in NaturalReader

After logging into your E-text Web page:

1. Click on the chapter or file you would like to view
2. While the file is open, choose the text you wish to be read or choose **Select All**
3. **Copy** the text
4. **Paste** the text into **NaturalReader**

### How to Use the Speech Feature in NaturalReader

1. On the left hand side of the screen, press the “**Play**” icon to begin reading the document
2. Press “**Stop**” or “**Pause**” to stop the text from reading

Vista users should use the voice “Anna” in this program. It is the most natural sounding voice.

### How to Enlarge Font in NaturalReader

1. Cut and paste the text you wish to enlarge into NaturalReader
2. Highlight the text with your mouse
3. Right click
4. Select “**Font**”
5. Choose the size of font (up to 72 pt)
6. Click “**OK**”

**Note:** The Mp3 button is not available in the “Free” version of NaturalReader.
